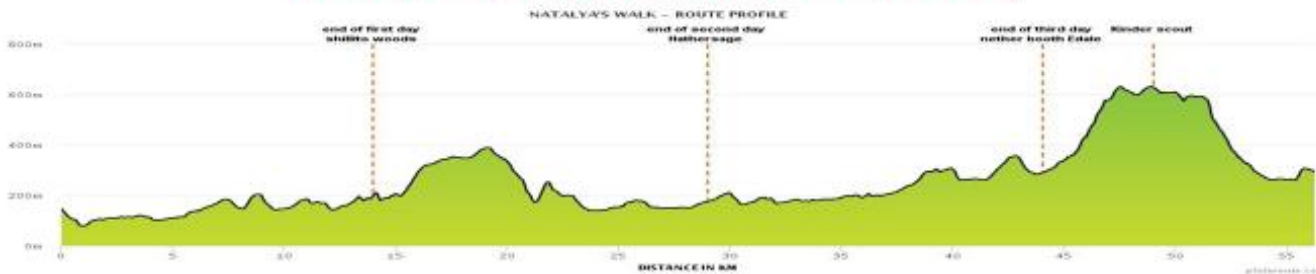
Her sister returned to St Peter and St Pauls in September 2016. Hugh, George and Ben, her best friends at SPSP decided to raise money in her name for
