Safeguarding - Car Park

In order to ensure that all our children arrive and leave SPSP safely can we once again politely remind parents of the following?

- The school drive and car park has a 5 mph speed limit - please adhere to this
- The car park operates on a one-way system - please be patient and understanding when vacating Brambling House after dropping off or collecting your child
- Drivers are expected to stop at the 'zebra crossing' area, which goes across the driveway to the playground pedestrian gate, if pupils and parents are approaching or waiting to cross

Our children's safety is paramount and driving slightly above the 5 mph speed limit puts them at risk - please help us to keep them safe.
