Year 6 'Crucial Crew' Trip to the Lifewise Centre in Rotherham - Thursday 19th January 2017

On Thursday 19th January 2017, Year 6 pupils will be attending Lifewise, a South Yorkshire led partnersjip initiative with the Fire Service and Local Authority, which promotes community safety and positive citizenship. The Lifewise Centre is situated at Hellaby Industrial Estate in Rotherham.

The Centre is a purpose bult arena within which scenario-based events are held. Crucial Crew is a life skills initiative that teaches children and young people how to deal with and avoid a range of potentially hazardous situations, by interacting in a realistic learning environment. Areas covered, linked to the PSHE Curriculum, will be - Community safety, Personal safety, Personal responsibility and Citizenship and Community Awareness.
