**Year 6 'Crucial Crew' at the Lifewise Centre in Rotherham - Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2017**

On Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2017 the Year 6 children enjoyed a fantastic experience at the Lifewise Centre in Rotherham. Crucial Crew is a personal safety educational programme delivered to Key Stage 2 pupils in Year 6. The programme runs in conjunction with South Yorkshire Fire & Rescue and is in partnership with Local Authorities, First Buses, Her Majesty's Court Service and the NHS Trust.

The children spent the day on 'the set', which is used to work through a series of real-life scenarios related to personal safety in an interactive and exciting way. The scenarios cover issues such as arson, hoax calls, road safety, fire safety, travel safety, internet safety and antisocial behaviour.

Highlights included Harry Briggs being invited to become a bus driver whilst Reece Reddish was convicted of theft and was sentenced to spend time (a few minutes!) in a prison cell!
