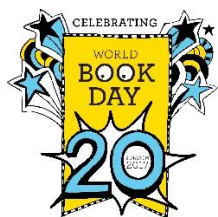

Nearly New uniform items for sale & John Lewis sample sizes are available to try.


The stock lists will be updated monthly and posted on the PTA/ Uniform Shop locker.
