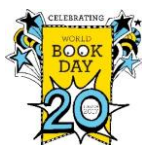
School Swimming Cap:

The uniform shop is also collecting any out grown unwanted **Christmas Jumpers**, child, and adult sizes. These will be resold next Christmas.

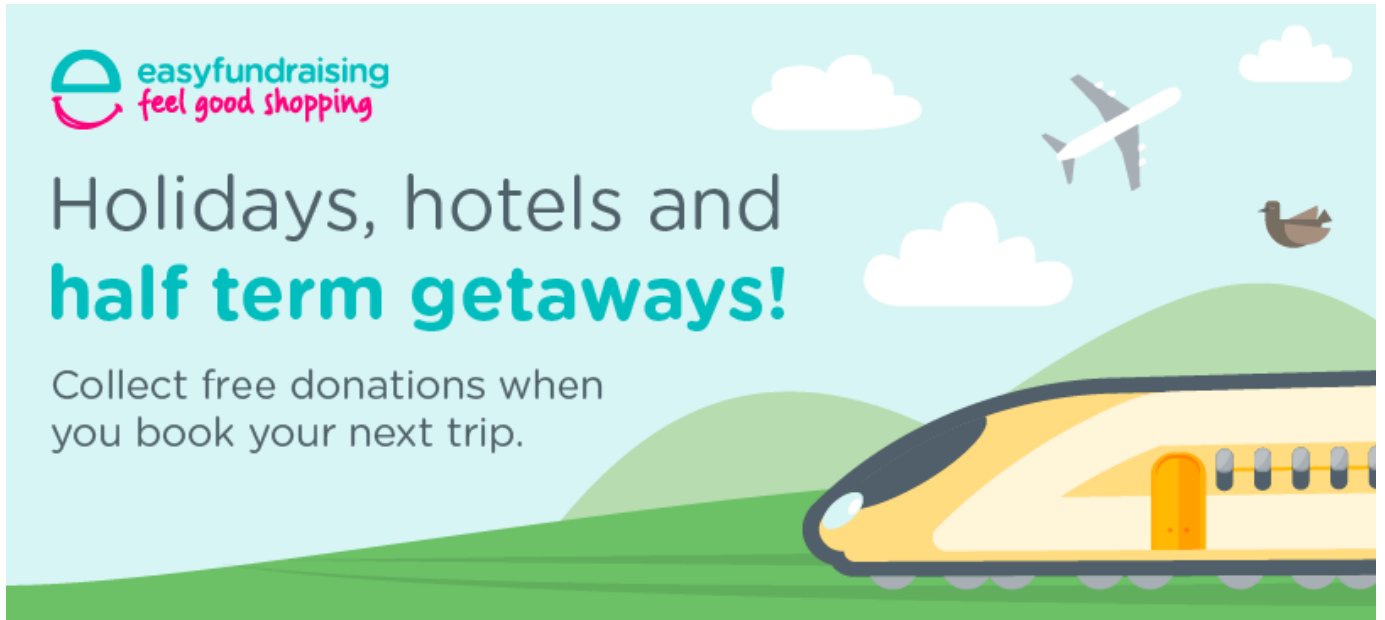
