On Wednesday afternoon it was the turn of the U11 Girls Rounders and U11 Boys Cricket. Both teams travelled back into Sheffield to take on Westbourne. The U11 Girls played in an exciting match. Sadie Gilliver bowled extremely well and restricted Westbourne to a score of 15 rounders from their 2 innings, with SPSP falling just short, scoring 9. The girls played with great determination in very warm conditions. In the cricket, the U11 Boys played a very entertaining game. Westbourne chose to bat first which looked a poor decision when Elliot Parker took 2 wickets in the first over. SPSP restricted the hosts to very limited opportunities to score before Westbourne's final pair came into bat. They made 27 from their 3 overs to give them a total of 264 runs. In reply, SPSP started extremely well and were ahead of the run rate until the last 3 overs. Sadly, despite the efforts of George Zwolinski & Elliot Parker, SPSP were unable to get the runs they needed in the last few overs as they finished with a score of 246.
