## *U8 Cricket@ BHS*

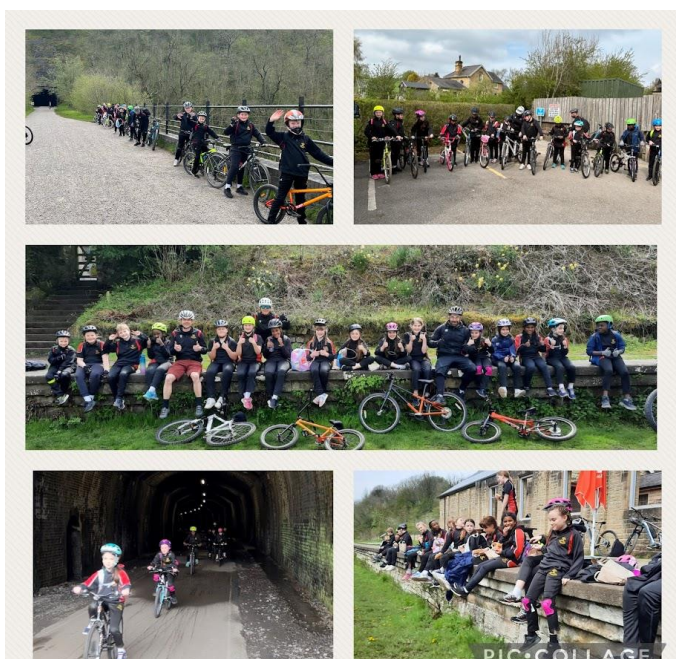
