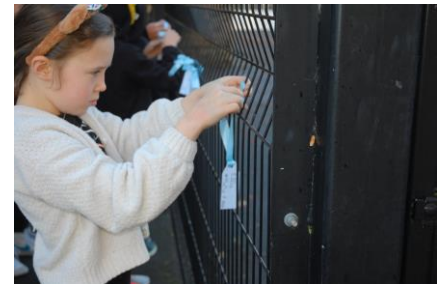




Anti-Bullying Week
